SUPPORT

Deployed/Homecoming Support

Must have been deployed at least two months to be eligible. Support services are available upon return to port.

2-4 Month Deployment:

- Pizza for duty section upon arrival (arrival day only).
- Snacks and refreshments for families while they are waiting on pier or at the Recreation Center.
- Face painter and balloon artist (four hours max).
- MWR facility usage for free during the event.
- Occasional sponsors on pier.

5-11 Month Deployment:

- Ports of call contact information.
- E-mail support for port visits.
- Half-way party assistance.
- Pre-arrival party for families to make posters and receive briefing on how the arrival days events will play out.
- Face painter, balloon artist, DJ and bounce toys available for kids (weather permitting).
- Pizza for duty section (for crews less than 500).
- Baby changing area.
- Ship rider available to provide area briefs on commands with crew greater than 500.

In-Port Support

All afloat commands are eligible for these services – others based on availability.

- Fitness and recreation equipment repair and replacement.
- Recreation Program Management training and assistance.
- Recreation Program Inspection assistance.
- Party and event planning support.
- Recreation information briefings.
- Visits or phone calls verifying command needs.
- Change of homeport assistance (maps, phone books, area guides and videos).
- Command, Ombudsman and Spouse group briefings available upon request.
- Fitness space design, purchase and installation support.

Training

DFS provides the required Afloat Recreation Program Management (ARPM) course for all afloat commands. This required training teaches RSO, FC and Recreation Committee members how to manage recreation funds and command recreation programs.

DFS staff conducts ARPM trainings a minimum of four times per year. Call the office to reserve a seat in the next available class.

Naval Base Kitsap Deployed Forces Support Equipment Request Form for Official Command Functions

The following Deployed Forces Support MWR equipment is provided FREE of charge to commands for Official Command Functions. These functions include, but are not limited to, homecomings, half-way parties, command picnics, holiday parties, pre-arrival events and, in some cases, change of command events.

This equipment is for use ONLY on board military installations to include, but not limited to: Naval Base Kitsap Bangor and Bremerton sites and may not be used at private residences or non-military facilities or properties.

Equipment may not be used for fundraisers or private parties. Commands will need to arrange for transportation and working party to pick up the equipment from the MWR warehouse at NBK Bremerton and return it to the warehouse when event is complete.

***Command representative must be a First Class or above.**
